



## GLENROSS GOLF COMMUNITY

The former Tanglewood golf course - an eighteen-hole "core" course - was the center of the development plan. In addition to the golf course, the client team had assembled over 350 acres of adjacent farmland. The plan was to build a new clubhouse, re-route and renovate some of the fairways, improve the drainage and add a new irrigation system. A cart path under Cheshire Road also serves as a bicycle/pedestrian route for Glenross residents. The master plan features 870 total units that are organized into eleven different neighborhoods - each anchored with a unique park or open space. Entry ways along Cheshire Road are delineated with stone piers, Scottish themed rubble walls and naturalistic, low maintenance plantings.
