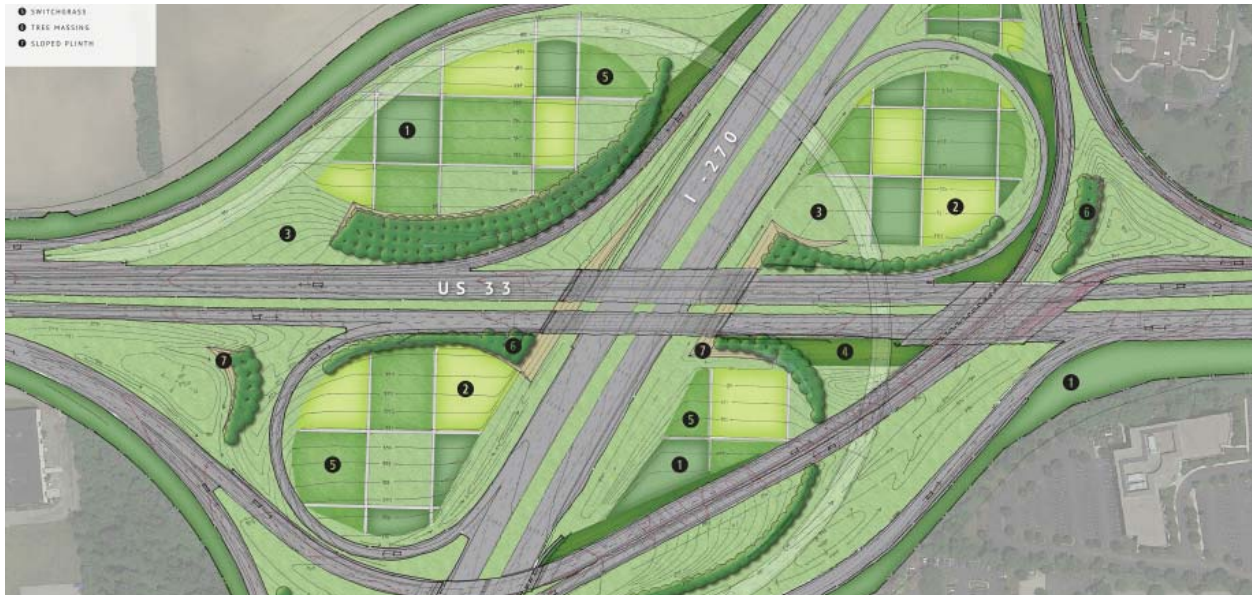


I-270 & SR 33 INTERCHANGE AESTHETICS

The City of Dublin engaged the landscape architects to collaboratively create a landscape master plan with a notable artist who was providing custom form designs for the MSE retaining walls that will line the interchange. Our role was to develop design alternatives that would be signature, welcoming, timeless, authentic, implementable and sustainable. The preferred option, which features “tilted planes” will be planted with ornamental grasses, shrubs and perennials in a grid like fashion. These planting grids will be delineated with concrete sidewalks that double as access routes for maintenance crews, and back-dropped with massive sweeping plantings of switchgrass and dawn redwoods. In addition to providing complete landscape plans our scope included grading plans and irrigation plans, as well as the design of freestanding aesthetic landscape walls. (Mr. Schmidt was PM for this project while with CT Consultants and teamed with EDGE).
